Dear Taxpayer:

Enclosed is the 2012 Limestone and Sand & Gravel Property Tax return for your use in reporting the status of these mineral properties as of January 1, 2012.

Please note that the return is due by April 16, 2012, and that you must report on all mineral reserves with a life of fifteen (15) years or less under your control by ownership or lease. Under Item 6, we need your most current names and addresses of owners in leases associated with a mining operation.

The form may be duplicated to satisfy your reporting needs. Operations which extend across county lines must be reported separately for the reserves within each county. If the map information requested in Item 7 did not change since your prior filing, you do not need to supply any maps with this return. **However, a complete return must be filed each year.**
