RECIPROCAL INCOME TAX AGREEMENT

between

COMMONWEALTH OF MENTUCKY

and

COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA

WHEREAS, under the existing laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky at the Commonwealth of Virginia, a Kentucky resident working in Virginia and anyong income from salary or wages from such work or a Virginia resident in Kentucky and deriving income from salary or wages from such work in his state of residence and commutes daily to his place of employment in the other state may be relieved from the filing of a nonrecident income the salary of employment; and a Kentucky employer of a Virginia resident who commutes daily to his place of work in Kentucky or a Virginia employer of a Kentucky resident who commutes daily to his place of work in Virginia ranges relieved from withholding income tax from the salary or wages of such personal

While Real, the laws of Kentucky and Virginia include reciprocal prounder which such nonresidents are exempt from net income taxes on their
respectively to the State of nonresidence provided the state of residence of
conresident individuals allows a similar exception and employers are except
withholding income tax provided the state of residence of such nonresident
individuals allows a similar exception; and

WHEREAS, large numbers of citizens and residents of Mantucky and Viginic commute to work on a daily basis and earn their livelihood in the neighbor-

whereas, it is the intention and desire of the tuning authorities of each state to collect taxes from their respective residents and relieve such a neresidents of the burden of filing nonresident income tax returns in the state of their employment, and employers of the burden of withholding income tax from such nonresidents;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to and in conformity with the laws and regulations of their reciprocal jurisdictions, the COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, by and through its Commissioner of Revenue, James E. Luckett, and the COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA, by and through its State Tax Commissioner, C. H. Morrissett, hereby covenant and agree as follows:

- 1. With respect to residents of the Commonwealth of Virginia virt. ve in Virginia and commute daily to their work in the Commonwealth of Kentu. . . and whose only income from Kentucky sources is in the form of salaries or vages, the Kentucky Department of Revenue will not require such individuals to fit a nonresident Kentucky income tax return.
- 2. With respect to residents of the Commonwealth of Rentucky who rive in Rentucky and commute daily to their work in the Commonwealth of Virguit and whose only income from Virginia scurces is in the form of salaries or way... the Virginia Department of Taxation will not require such individuals to file a virginial resident Virginia income text return.
- 3. With respect to employers located in the Commonwealth of Virginia who employ Kentucky residents who commute daily to their work in Virginia, he Virginia Department of Taxation will not require such employers to withheld income taxes from the wages or salaries of such Kentucky residents who file with their employers certificates of nonresidence.

- 4. With respect to employers located in the Commonwealth of Mentucky who employ Virginia residents who commute daily to their work in Kentucky, the Kentucky Department of Revenue will not require such employers to withhold income taxes from the wages or salaries of such Virginia residents who file with their employers certificates of nonresidence.
- 5. The provisions of this reciprocal agreement shall become officetive for all tatable years beginning on and after the first day of January, 1965, and shall remain effective until such time as the laws of either state may rataire a change in the agreement.
