

The Kentucky Department of Revenue is transitioning to a new integrated tax system and launching a new business tax portal called MyTaxes. The launch of these new systems will indirectly affect individual income tax filers. Due to these system transitions, the Kentucky Department of Revenue will have a temporary pause in operations from February 26 to March 14, where staff will not be able to process returns or issue refunds.

Kentuckians can file individual income tax returns at any point from today, January 27, to the deadline on April 15. If you anticipate a refund, we recommend filing as soon as possible to avoid a delay in receiving it due to DOR's two-week operations pause.
