

## Reminder: Withholding and Sales & Use Tax December Due Dates

**Please Note:** No filing frequencies have changed. This courtesy email series, scheduled to be sent monthly, is to notify Withholding and Sales & Excise tax filers of upcoming due dates.

December brings multiple due dates for Withholding and Sales & Excise tax filers. Don't forget to login to <a href="MyTaxes">MyTaxes</a>, our new business taxpayer portal, to review and update your demographic information, make payments, file returns, and submit refund applications.

Taxes that should be paid in the Portal include Sales & Use, Corporation Income (Corp)/Limited Liability Entity (LLE), Telecom, Withholding, Utilities Gross Receipts License (UGRLT), Non-Resident Withholding (NRWH), Commercial Mobile Radio Service (CMRS), Tire, and Transient.

## The following due dates are coming in December:

December 10th - Withholding Bimonthly

December 15th - Withholding Monthly

December 22nd - Monthly and Quarterly Regular Sales & Use, Telecom, UGRLT, CMRS,

Tire, and Transient

December 29th - Accelerated Sales & Use December 29th - Withholding Bimonthly
