

Reminder: Withholding and Sales & Use Tax May Due Dates

Reminder

May brings multiple due dates for Withholding and Sales & Excise tax filers. Don't forget to login to MyTaxes, our new business taxpayer portal, to make payments, file returns, and submit refund applications.

Taxes that should be paid in the Portal include Sales & Use, Corporation Income (Corp)/Limited Liability Entity (LLE), Telecom, Withholding, Utilities Gross Receipts License (UGRLT), Non-Resident Withholding (NRWH), Commercial Mobile Radio Service (CMRS), Tire, and Transient.

The following due dates are coming in May:

May 12th - Withholding Bimonthly

May 15th - Withholding Monthly

May 20th - Monthly Regular Sales & Use, Telecom, UGRLT, CMRS, Tire, and Transient

May 26th - Accelerated Sales & Use

May 27th - Withholding Bimonthly
